HAMILTON TOWNSHIP FIRE DEPARTMENT

Regarding miscellaneous Hamilton Township Fire Department matters, Chief Hafey informed the Board of the following: department completed an online and hands-on PEDS class on May 25th; Obetz sponsored a vaccine clinic, turnout was not what was expected; one firefighter is on light duty for approximately two months performing various office tasks for the chief. A brief discussion was held regarding the intended use for this 40-hour light duty position. This employee was not injured on the job, he has sick leave hours. Trustee Craiglow stated that he was not in favor of allowing any employee to work in this position instead of using sick leave. This was not fair to the Township taxpayers. Sick leave is provided for a reason and off the job injuries and the associated time off should be charged to the employee's sick leave bank. Chief Hafey stated that he did not have to ask the Board's permission to place an employee on the light duty assignment, per the CBA he has the authority to make this decision; new hand-held radios have been ordered. The old radios are to be returned to Columbus; Chief Hafey is working with zoning on 825 Olympia Drive issues; fire crews attended a welcome home celebration at the Fortress Obetz for soldiers returning home from Afghanistan; EMS services are being provided for Bike Nights at the Fortress, all special duty assignments are being filled; provided EMS services for Hamilton Local Schools graduation ceremony at the Fortress; and contacting

Abbott Electric and having them check the electrical drops in Station 171, plugs may be bad.
