

The Special Meeting of the Hamilton Township Board of Trustees was called to order at 7:30 p.m., by Chairman Chris Hann.

Meeting regarding community involvement in support of the upcoming issues, fire department levies. Board of Trustees are asking for support from the surrounding communities, Obetz, Lockbourne, Reese and Shadeville.

Board discussed the talking points to be addressed with the public when there are specific questions regarding the need for an increase in millage.

Trustee Armstrong presented a document he had prepared listing both the old and new levy millage and collection amounts along with the cost for the current levies to the taxpayer and the cost after the increase. Also included was the projected operating cost for the fire department for the next three years.

Trustees discussed the need to communicate to the taxpayers the need for the levies and the potential problems created if the levies are not approved. The Board is to schedule an organizational meeting for the levy committee as soon as possible.
